## Instructions for use

## Product description:

Debrisoft® consists of polyester fibres, the reverse side is coated with polyacrylate.

The product is individually packed and sterile (heat treated). Debrisoft® is for single

use only and must not be re-sterilized. The product is sterile as long as the packaging remains unopened and undamaged.

Indications:

In wound bed preparation, Debrisoft® is intended as a rapid, highly effective and

safe debridement method in the treatment of superficial wounds and the surrounding

skin, for example in cases of

- diabetic ulcers
- arterial and venous ulcers
- pressure ulcers

postoperative wounds healing by second intention

Debrisofte can also be used for absorbing exudate, cellular debris and keratosis during debridement. Debrisofte is gentle on intact tissue.

## Please note:

There are also very good results with Debrisoft® in the treatment of wounds with major keratotic and necrotic coatings, provided these wounds have previously been treated with autolytic debridement.

Adverse reactions:

None known to date.

Application:

1. Remove the existing wound dressing.

2. Debridement procedure:

a) Soak Debrisofte with e.g. water or saline, according to local guidelines.

b) Wipe the wound surface gently without pressure using the soft fibre side of the thoroughly moistened Debrisoft® (recommended quantity to moisten:

approx. 20-40 ml).

c) If required, cleanse the peri wound skin with another thoroughly moistened  $\ensuremath{\mathsf{Debrisoft}}\xspace$  .

3. Following use, standard treatment for the condition should be continued. **Precautions:** 

• Debrisofte must not be left on the wound.

• The product must not be used in case of known intolerance or an allergy against

one or more of its constituents.

• Debrisoft® must not be cut to size
